1.06 CLARIFICATIONS

- A. Questions and Answers
 - 1. Q: Sheet C200, northwest side of the proposed building shows a 4" outlet for the floor drains. Is this meant to be the outlet for the building foundation drain tile? If not where does the building drain tile daylight?
 - A: Yes, that is the building drain tile outlet.
 - Q: Sheet C200 on the south side of the site the notes call out a stormwater filtration basin. What are the dimensions of the required basin?
 - A: The basin has a 2' bottom width and returns to the parking lot/roadway grade at 3:1 (H:V).
 - 3. Q: Does Superior Water & Light make the connection at the waterline?
 - A: Water line is owned by the Town of Superior. Contractor to make connection to water main. See Architectural Specifications for water district notification.
 - 4. Q: Is there any drain tile piping required within the stormwater filtration basin?
 - A: No.
 - Q: For bidding purposes associated with the sanitary sewer line called out on sheet C200, what is the proposed alignment, pipe size, and pipe type?
 - A: Sanitary line exits building from SW corner. Line to extend from building using same materials and size to existing sanitary holding tank.
 - 6. Q: Is the owner responsible for site and building layout?
 - A: There is an existing survey available at our office. The contractor must layout out building corners, grid lines, and control points.
 - 7. Q: Is the owner responsible for testing?
 - A: The contractor is only responsible for testing per requirements in individual spec sections. All other testing will be done by the owner.
