ORDINANCE 1992 - 2

ATV ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, hereby establishes as follows:

Section 1 DEFINITION.

"All-terrain vehicle" has the meaning specified under Wisconsin Statute 340.01(2g) and is as follows:

"An engine-driven device which has a net weight of 500 pounds or less, which has a width of 46 inches or less, which is equipped with a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and which is designed to travel on 3 or more low-pressure tires. A low-pressure tire is a tire which has a minimum width of 6 inches, which is designed to be mounted on a rim with a maximum diameter of 12 inches and which is designed to be inflated with an operating pressure not to exceed 6 pounds per square inch as recommended by the manufacturer."

Section 2 INTENT.

A. The Town Board of the Town of Superior hereby accepts the ATV ordinance of the Town of Superior which adopts the following Wisconsin Statute verbatim or with subsequent changes thereto:

Wisconsin Statute 23.33 - All-Terrain Vehicles.

- B.l. In addition to the foregoing, all ATVs operating on designated routes shall operate or travel in a single file.
- B.2. In addition to the foregoing, no ATV shall do racing of any kind on any designated ATV route.

Section 3 DESIGNATED ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES.

The following roads are hereby designated as ATV routes. (Some of the roads will be renamed in 1992 to adapt to the new county numbering system. The old and the new names will be given in cases that apply.)

No person shall operate an ATV except on these designated ATV routes and then only if such designated ATV routes are marked as designated ATV routes.

Section 4 TERMINATION OF ROUTE DESIGNATION.

Whenever, in the judgment of the Town Board, the use of an ATV route or routes become(s) unsafe to the operators of ATV's, pedestrians, residents, or automobile traffic, the Town Board, in its discretion, may close such road or roads as an ATV route and shall remove the markers designating them as an ATV route.

Section 5 PENALTIES.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance may be fined not less than Twenty-five and no/100 (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty and no/100 (\$50.00) Dollars for the first offense, and not less than Fifty and no/100 (\$50.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars for following offenses.

Section 6 EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in effect from and after the passage and publication as provided by law.
