All-Terrain Vehicle/ Utility Terrain Vehicle Route Town of Superior, Douglas County

AN ORDINANCE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE/UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES (1992-02)

Section I - Intent

The Town of Superior, Douglas County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle/utility terrain vehicle ordinance/route for the operation of all-terrain vehicles/utility terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this route(s) has been created.

Section II - Statutory Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin has the specific authority to adopt this All-Terrain Vehicle and Utility Terrain Vehicle Route Ordinance under s. 23.33 (8) (b) and (11), Wis. stats.

Section III - Routes

The Town of Superior Board on April 11th, 2018 amended the ATV/UTV routes to now have <u>ALL Town of Superior roads open as ATV/UTV routes</u>, this does not include state & county roads. Private roads are not controlled by the Town on ATV/UTV issues.

Section IV - Revocation of ATV/UTV Routes

The Town Board of the Town of Superior specifically reserves the right to rescind this ordinance or to remove or modify all or sections of designated ATV/UTV Routes listed in Section III, at any time.

Section V - Conditions

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. All ATV/UTV operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.
- B. All ATV/UTV operators shall ride single file.
- C. All ATV/UTV operators shall slow the vehicle to 10-mph or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling.
- D. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7)c.

Section VI - Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state of Wisconsin.

Section VII - Penalties

Wisconsin state All-Terrain Vehicle and Utility Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33 (13) (a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section VIII - Severability

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

Section IX - Effective Date

This ordinance replaces ATV Ordinance 1992-2 approved April 8, 1992 and amended February 10, 1993. The ordinance is effective on publication or posting. The town clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80 Wis.Stats.
