

TOWN OF SUPERIOR  
DOUGLAS COUNTY, WISCONSIN  
PROHIBITING ISSUANCE OF MUNICIPAL LICENSES  
FOR NONPAYMENT OF TAXES, ASSESSMENTS AND CLAIMS (ORDINANCE 1.14)

**SECTION I.** In addition to the requirements imposed by Chapter 125 of Wisconsin Statutes, this ordinance is adopted pursuant to authority conferred under section 66.0115, and Tavern League v. Madison, 131 Wis. 2d 477, 389 N.W.2d 54 (Ct. App. 1986). This ordinance is to be interpreted in conformance with those sections as they may be amended from time to time.

**SECTION II.**

- A. No license or permit shall be granted for operation on any premises upon which taxes, assessments or other claims of the Town of Superior are delinquent or unpaid.
- B. Licenses and permits will only be renewed upon receipt of full payment of delinquent taxes, assessments and other claims of the Town of Superior.

**SECTION V – SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is declared invalid, the invalidity shall not affect the provisions or application of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.

**SECTION VI - REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.** All existing town ordinances and resolutions, part of ordinances and resolutions, and amendments thereto in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


**SECTION VII - EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.
