

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF
FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES TO PERSONS
UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS.

The Town or Village of Superior, Douglas County,
Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section I.

No fermented malt beverages shall be sold, dis-
pensed, given away or furnished to any person under the age
of twenty-one (21) years unless accompanied by parent or
guardian.

Section II.

Any person who shall violate the provisions of
this Ordinance shall forfeit to (the town or village of
Superior) a sum not exceeding \$500.00 and in de-
fault of the payment of such forfeiture and the costs of
the action for its collection, shall be committed to the
county jail until such forfeiture and costs be paid but
not to exceed ninety (90) days.

Section III.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section IV.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force
from and after its passage and publication.
