

LIQUOR and BEER ORDINANCE of the TOWN of SUPERIOR

It shall be unlawful for any person under twenty-one (21) years of age to have intoxicating liquor in his or her possession. Any person under twenty-one (21) years of age who falsely represents himself as of age in order to obtain intoxicating liquor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.


Any person violating any of the terms or provisions of these ordinances shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the County Jail not exceeding eighty-five (85) days.

BEER ORDINANCE

It shall be unlawful for any person under twenty-one (21) years of age to have ~~non~~-intoxicating malt liquor in his or her possession. No license shall be granted to any person under twenty-one (21) years of age who falsely represents himself as of age in order to obtain non-intoxicating malt liquor. Anyone who does shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

The foregoing ordinance passed and adopted at a meeting of the Board of Supervisors held at the Town Hall on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1947.
