

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS,
HAWKERS AND ITINERANT MERCHANTS


The Town Board of the Town of Superior, Douglas County,
Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The practice of going in or upon private residences, business establishments, or offices in the Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants and transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, business establishments or offices for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise and/or peddling or hawking the same or soliciting subscriptions for magazines or other periodicals is hereby declared unlawful.

SECTION 2. If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or other part of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts hereof.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not more than \$ _____ and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the county jail until payment of such forfeiture and the costs of prosecution, but not exceeding _____ days for each violation.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting.
