

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE HOURS DURING  
WHICH FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES AND/OR  
INTOXICATING LIQUOR SHALL NOT BE SOLD

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, DOUGLAS COUNTY,  
WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: No premises for which a Retail Fermented Malt Beverage License has been issued shall be permitted to remain open for the sale, vending, dealing, serving or trafficking in or giving away of fermented malt beverages as follows:

1. (a) As a Retail Class "A" Fermented Malt Beverage License, no such premises shall be permitted to remain open for the sale, vending, dealing, serving or trafficking in or giving away of fermented malt beverages as a Retail Class "A" Licensee, or for any other purpose, between the hours of 9:00 p. m. and 8:00 a. m.

1. (b) As a Retail Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage License, no such premises shall be permitted to remain open for the sale, vending, dealing, serving or trafficking in or giving away of fermented malt beverages as a Retail Class "B" Licensee, or for any other purpose, between the hours of 1:00 a. m. and 8:00 a. m.; except during that portion of 1959 and each year thereafter for which the standard of time is advanced under Section 175.095 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the closing hours shall be between 2:00 a. m. and 8:00 a. m., and on January 1 when the closing hours shall be between 3:00 a. m. and 8:00 a. m.

1. (c) Restaurants and food stores whose principal business is the furnishing of food or the sale of food stuffs and other merchandise to patrons shall be permitted to remain open for the conduct of their regular business but shall not be permitted to sell fermented malt beverages during the hours mentioned in Sections 1. (a) and 1. (b).

SECTION II: No premises for which a Retail Intoxicating Liquor License has been issued shall be permitted to remain open for the sale, vending, dealing, serving or trafficking in or giving away of intoxicating liquor as follows:

2. (a) As a Retail Intoxicating Liquor Class "A" License, no such premises shall be permitted to remain open for the sale, vending, dealing, serving or trafficking in or giving away of intoxicating liquor as a Retail Class "A" Licensee, or for any other purpose, between the hours of 9:00 p. m. and 8:00 a. m.

2. (b) As a Retail Intoxicating Liquor Class "B" License, no such premises shall be permitted to remain open for the sale, vending, dealing, serving or trafficking in or giving away of Intoxicating Liquor as a Retail Class "B" Licensee, or for any other purpose, between the hours of 1:00 a. m. and 8:00 a. m.; except during that portion of 1959 and each year thereafter for which the standard of time is advanced under Section 175.095 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the closing hours shall be between 2:00 a. m. and 8:00 a. m., and on January 1 when the closing

hours shall be between 3:00 a. m. and 8:00 a. m.

SECTION III: Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit to the Town of Superior a sum not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and in default of the payment of such forfeiture and the costs of the action for its collection, shall be committed to the county jail of Douglas County, Wisconsin until such forfeiture and costs be paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: The hours set forth hereinabove shall be construed to refer to Standard Time when such time is in effect in the Town of Superior, and Daylight Saving Time when such time is in effect in the Town of Superior.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall be posted pursuant to law, and shall take effect and be in full force the day after the proof of such posting has been filed and recorded by the Town Clerk pursuant to law.
