

SNOWMOBILE RACING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, deems the regulation of snowmobile racing for the good order of the Town and for the safety, welfare and convenience of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED:

1. No person, corporation or business enterprise shall conduct snowmobile races within the boundaries of the Town of Superior without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Town Board.

2. Application for said permit shall be made in writing to the Town Clerk not less than thirty days prior to the first date for holding such snowmobile race. Such application shall disclose full information as to the names and residences of the individuals or corporate owners and managers conducting such races; the intended location and time and dates thereof; proof of liability insurance; proof of adequate parking and sanitary facilities for the public; plans for sound amplification, if any; and such other information as the Board shall require and such information shall be submitted and sworn to.

3. Such permit shall not be granted where in the reasonable judgment of the Board, the good order of the Town is adversely affected or where the safety, welfare or convenience of the public may be materially jeopardized.

4. This Ordinance may be enforced by injunction in any court of competent jurisdiction.

5. Any license granted hereunder may be revoked if any of the conditions necessary for the issuing of, or contained in the license are not complied with.

6. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or ninety days in the Douglas County Jail, or both.

7. This ordinance shall become effective upon its posting or publication, according to law.
