**SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE**  
The Town Board of the Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows:  
Section 1. The following highways are hereby designated as snowmobile routes: Baumgartner Road, Darrow, Emil Johnson Road, Mansky, Neuman, Van Horenweder, Oscar Peterson, Nordley, Circle, Daring, Gustafson, Hunter, Karsky, Tuff, Leggate, Reed Merrill and Station Roads.  
Section 2. No person shall operate a snowmobile on the designated snowmobile routes in the following manner:  
a. At a rate of speed that is unreasonable or improper under the circumstances.  
b. In any careless way so as to endanger the person or property of others.  
c. While under the influence of intoxicating liquor, fermented malt beverages, narcotics or other drugs.  
d. In such a way that the exhaust of the motor makes an excessive or unusual noise.  
e. Without a functioning muffler.  
Section 3. All snowmobiles operating on designated snowmobile routes shall operate in single file and shall yield the right of way to automobiles legally on said highways.  
Section 4. All snowmobiles must come to a complete stop before entering on town roads and at all road intersections and shall yield the right of way at said places to automobiles on said highways.  
Section 5. No snowmobiles shall do racing of any kind on any designated snowmobile route.  
Section 6. All snowmobiles operating on designated snowmobile routes shall comply with Section 350.09 Wisconsin Statutes as to lighting and brakes.  
Section 7. No person shall operate a snowmobile on any town road except a designated snowmobile route.  
Whenever, in the judgment of the Town Board, the use of any snowmobile route becomes unsafe to the operators of snowmobiles, pedestrians or automobile traffic, the Town Board at its discretion and without notice may close such highway as a snowmobile route and shall immediately after doing so forthwith remove the markers designating the same as a snowmobile route.  
Section 8. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance may be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for the first offense, and not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the second offense within a year.  
Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in effect from and after the passage and publication as provided by law.
