RESOLUTION TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

The Town Board of the Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

An emergency is declared as existing within the Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, when any of the following may occur: Storm damage and/or washed out roads and/or downed trees to the extent that cleanup and repair is beyond the scope of the Town's abilities and funds.

The period of emergency shall be limited to the time during which the emergency conditions exist or are likely to exist within the Town of Superior.

The Town Board, or its designated agents, has the authority to order whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare, and good order to the Town of Superior during any such emergency, including without limitation to bar, restrict, and remove all unnecessary traffic, vehicular or pedestrian, from the local highways.

The Town Clerk shall post this resolution under s. 60.80, Wis. Statutes. This resolution shall become effective retroactive to June 15, 2018, at which time the Town Board moved to declare a state of emergency.
